Dear Interested and Affected Party,

Notice is hereby given of a Public Participation Process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998; "NEMA"), as amended, in terms of both and the Section 24G Fine Regulations, 2017 and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (as amended). As the alleged activity took place prior to the Applicant obtaining Environmental Authorisation, in terms of the below listed activities, this application is being undertaken to obtain ex post facto approval in terms of Section 24G of NEMA. A S24G process will therefore be followed, and an application is intended to be submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs & Development Planning (DEA&DP) directorate of rectification.

NEMA activities allegedly undertaken without authorisation:

- Activities allegedly commenced with post 2010 that required authorisation in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulates dated 2 August 2010 which were the lawful regulations at the time:
 - GN No. R. 544 of 2010 (Listing Notice 1 of 2010): Activity 18
- Activities allegedly commenced with post 2014 that required authorisation in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations dated 8 December 2014 (as amended) which were the lawful regulations at the time:
 - Government Notice No. 327 of 2014 (Listing Notice 1 of 2014): Activity 19
- These activities would likely still require authorization today in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulates dated 8 December 2014 (as amended) which are the current lawful regulations in place.

NEMA Listed Activities Applied For:

Listing Notice 1 of 2010 (GN554):

Activity 18: The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 5 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 5 cubic metres from

- (i) a watercourse;
- (ii) the seashore; or
- (iii) the littoral active zone, an estuary or a distance of 100 metres inland of the high-water mark of the sea or an estuary, whichever distance is the greater

but excluding where such infilling, depositing, dredging, excavation, removal or moving

- (a) is for maintenance purposes undertaken in accordance with a maintenance management plan; or
- (b) will occur behind a development setback

Listing Notice 1 of 2014 (GN327 of 2014):

Activity 19: The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 10 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 10 cubic metres from a watercourse but excluding where such infilling, depositing, dredging, excavation, removal or moving—

- (i) will occur behind a development setback;
- (ii) is for maintenance purposes undertaken in accordance with a maintenance management plan; [or]
- (iii) falls within the ambit of activity 21 in this Notice, in which case that activity applies;
- (iv) occurs within existing ports or harbours that will not increase the development footprint of the port or harbour; or
- (v) where such development is related to the development of a port or harbour, in which case activity 26 in Listing Notice 2 of 2014 applies.

A NEMA Section 24G Application is intended to be submitted to Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP) Directorate: Environmental Governance (Rectification) to carry out the following:

Activity: Implementation of the proposed densified social housing development as initiated by means of the piping of portions of Wetland 7 beyond the extent authorised under the existing Environmental Authorisation (October 2011).

Location: Erf 3733 Mandalay

Name of Proponent: Mandalay SH Project (Pty) Ltd

Date of contraventions: June 2013 and May 2017
